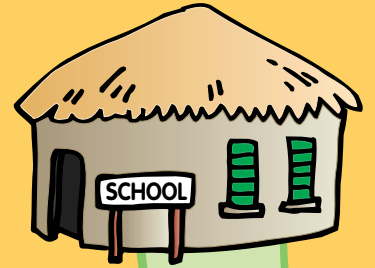


Why don't all children go to school?
